

HINDOLVESTON VILLAGE SCREEN

Since our last report we have had more live screenings as part of a trial set up by Creative Arts East. Although this was very successful unfortunately Creative Arts East has not yet been able to organise a system that will work for small village screens.

We show 8 films in a year with one season in the autumn and one in the spring. The audience numbers average forty nine people for each film. For each film shown we have to pay a licence fee which is usually about £100 but sometimes it can be as much as £175 but despite this we have been able to make a profit for the Village Hall.

This last season we have started showing foreign language films, two in the autumn season and two in the spring season, as well as the usual eight films. This is proving successful and we are attracting a different audience, so we plan to continue this next season.
