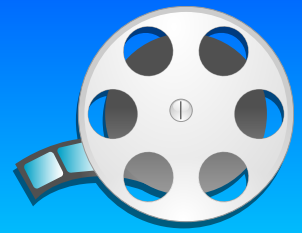

Saturday 16th March THE WIFE

A tense drama based on the best-selling Meg Wolitzer book. In a superb acting role, Glenn Close plays an elegant woman who has spent forty years sacrificing her own ambitions to support her charismatic husband and his literary career. On the eve of his Nobel Prize award, she confronts the biggest sacrifice of her life and the secret of his career...

Saturday 30th March SHOPLIFTERS (Japanese with English subtitles)

A charming and wonderful film directed by Hirokazu Koreeda. A Japanese couple and family avail themselves of shoplifting to make ends meet. They come across a little girl in the freezing cold and decide to take care of her. Despite their continued hardship, this newly-modified family lives happily – until an incident begins to test their bond. (Winner of the Palme D'Or at Cannes 2018)

Saturday 20th April LEAVE NO TRACE

A thoughtful film about an Iraq War veteran with PTSD and his teenage daughter who have lived off-grid, undetected for years in the forests on the edge of Portland, Oregon. A chance encounter leads to their discovery, and their idyllic life is shattered when both are put into social services. They set off on a perilous journey back to their wild homeland - seeking their previous complete independence...
